

Quick reference guide

- Make sure you have a working UK bank account.
- Have waterproof luggage or line your cases with bin bags.
- Bring any medication that you need.
- Make sure you have a record of your national insurance number and your passport/driving licence.
- On Penzance quay make sure you have red luggage labels on your bags if travelling on the Scillonian.
- Have your waterproofs close at hand for the boat between the islands.
- When you're on the boat to St Martin's call the farm 01720 422 169 or Neil so we know what time and which quay to pick you up from.
